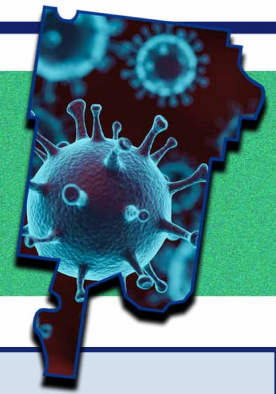


CLAYTON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS COVID-19 PROTOCOLS



FOR EMPLOYEES

COVID-19 Symptomatic Vaccinated and Unvaccinated:

Employees should follow these guidelines if experiencing symptoms:

- Do not report to work
- Notify supervisor
- Test for COVID-19

COVID-19 Positive Test Results:

Employees diagnosed (test positive) with COVID-19

- Do not report to work
- Consult medical provider
- Self-Report to CCPS COVID-19 Portal
- Contact supervisor
- Self-Isolate for five days
- Return to work on day six, if symptoms improve

Exposure - Test to Stay:

- Allows employee who should quarantine to continue in the work environment.
- The employee must test on day 3 from known exposure and again on day 5.
- Employee reports to work after being exposed wearing a tight fitting mask.
- Test results must be reported to Supervisor

COVID-19 Exposure: If an employee is vaccinated or unvaccinated and deemed a close contact in the work environment but **NOT** exhibiting symptoms:

- Report to work
- Self-Report to the CCPS COVID-19 Portal
- No quarantine required
- Practice social distancing, sanitize hands, monitor symptoms, COVID-19 Test in 3-5 days from exposure
- CCPS Health Team may follow-up
- Remote work is not available

International Travel:

Fully Vaccinated and Vaccinated

- Return to work
- Test 3-5 days upon return from travel

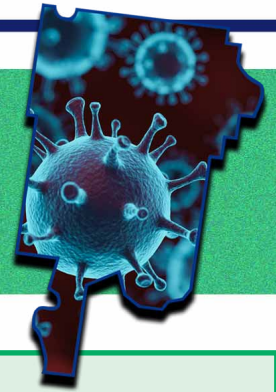
Unvaccinated

- Self-quarantine for 5 days
- Test 3-5 days upon return from travel
- Return to work with a negative test

Employee leave related to COVID-19 symptoms, positive test, exposure and travel will be entered as Sick Leave.

FOR STUDENTS

COVID-19 Symptomatic Vaccinated or Unvaccinated:

Students should use these guidelines

- Do not report to school
- Test for COVID-19
- Consult medical provider, if needed
- Notify teacher of illness

COVID-19 Positive Test Results:

If a student is diagnosed (tested positive) with COVID-19:

- Do not report to school
- Self-report to the CCPS COVID-19 portal
- Report diagnosis to teacher
- Consult medical provider, if needed
- Remain out of school, isolate as directed by COVID-19 Response Team

Exposure - Test to Stay:

- Allows students who should quarantine to continue in person learning
- The student must test on day 3 from known exposure and again on day 5.
- Test results should be provided to the Healthcare Tech at the school.
- Student must wear a tight fitting mask.

COVID-19 Exposure: Every student and family should monitor their health daily and, if an immediate family member receives a COVID-19-positive diagnosis or if the student is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, he or she should not report to school:

If Student is Vaccinated: No quarantine is required unless symptomatic
If Student is not Vaccinated

- If both students are masked and contact between students is greater than 3 feet and plexi-glass is available, no quarantine
- If both students are masked, no plexi-glass is available, and contact is less than 3 feet, the student can Test to Stay
- Report exposure to the COVID-19 Self Reporting Portal
- CCPS COVID Responses Team may follow-up

Student Learning During Quarantine due to COVID-19

Virtual Studies Temporary Engagement Program (VSTEP) will provide virtual studies:

- for students who have been Quarantined (QRT) or Isolated (ISO). These students will receive instruction for a temporary amount of time outside of their zoned schools.
